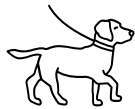

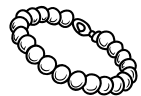

# STEP 3

## Profit Formula

To make money, you need to know how much things cost—and how much you'll charge.

Use this formula:

$$\text{Revenue} - \text{Cost} = \text{Profit}$$

### Example:



You sell lemonade for **\$1 a cup.**



You spend **\$5 on supplies.**



You sell **10 cups = \$10 revenue.**

$$\mathbf{\$10} - \mathbf{\$5} = \mathbf{\$5}$$

Revenue

Cost

Profit
